Each session includes a presentation by NSU faculty followed by an open discussion with participants to help stimulate and strengthen Norfolk's small business community.

In addition to the core curriculum, participants will be able to attend supplemental workshops on topics such as credit worthiness, side hustles and lifestyle businesses, participate in pop-ups and other special events and receive ongoing one-on-one consulting from experts in various fields.

Businesses who actively attend all eight of the weekly sessions will be given first consideration for a Selden Market storefront. Businesses who are interested in opening a storefront at Selden Market are highly encouraged to attend and participate in the *Align* series.
